



COVID-19 - Operational Guidelines for Services

Before coming to church

- Each family will monitor their own temperature and health at home and the family will stay home if there is an individual that may be sick or at risk of sickness
- Church services will be available online via Zoom

Entrance & Exit

- There will be a door person to open and close the front doors of the church
- Signage will be placed outside the building with operational guidelines
- Each person is asked to wear a mask from their vehicle to their pew and when they return to their vehicle.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided at the entrance
- The water fountain will be covered and not used
- Bulletin's will be provided digitally on the church website
- All handouts will be removed

Offering

- Offering will not be taken during services
- The offering box slots will be available at the back for giving tithes & offerings.

Pews

- Pews will be marked off every other pew for use. Each family will be seated together and will use the same pew(s) week after week.
- Song books will be kept to each pew row to prevent sharing between families
- Additional seating of pews will be setup in the fellowship hall for overflow seating with the same assigned seating and cleaning standards

Classes

- Each class will fit occupancy to allow safe distance practices where possible
- Where safe distancing is not possible, masks will be recommended

Restrooms

- Restrooms will remain available
- Restrooms will be wiped down after each use
- Each person asked to limit the touching of surfaces as much as possible

Kitchen

- The kitchen will be closed off from access or use

Nursery

- The nursery will be closed for use
